## RULES \& REGULATIONS

1. The South Carolina State Fair General Rules and Regulations shall apply in conjunction with The South Carolina State Fair Flower Show General Rules and Regulations.
2. The Arrangement/Designs Division is open to any amateur arranger. You do not have to be a Rose Society member. The Arrangement/Designs Division is NOT open to professional florists or anyone who arranges flowers for a living.
3. All arrangements are by advance entry only and may be limited to four (4) per class due to space.
4. Roses of high quality should be used in all arrangements, but need not have been grown by the exhibitor. All roses must be named \{ARS Am. Exhibition Name\} on the entry tag. "AG" should be written or checked in the box at the card top for arrangements featuring Arranger-Grown roses. All roses must be outdoor garden grown. Classes 2-14 with "AG" are eligible for medal certificates.
5. ROSES must be the DOMINANT FLOWERS in all arrangements. The rose bloom may not be abstracted. Roses used in Classes 8-13 must be ones classified as miniature or miniflora.
6. Other plant material may be used in classes where permitted. The use of artificial plant material treated or painted fresh plant material, and the use of live creatures are not permitted. The American Flag is not permitted in any form.
7. Niches will be provided and must be used. Niche sizes: Classes $1-7$ are $36 " \mathrm{H} \times 24$ "W x 18"D". Classes 8-13 are $10^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 10^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 10^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$. The mini niches sides will be triangular. Class 14 (Duke) are $22^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{H} \times 24^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W} \times 24^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{D}$ Backgrounds and underlays are to be used in all classes and must be furnished by the exhibitor. Accessories are permitted in all classes, except Class 14.
8. Decisions of the Judges will be final. Judging will be in accordance with the American Rose Society Guidelines for Judging Rose Arrangements. Only authorized personnel will be allowed in the area during judging.
9. Entry cards will be furnished by show committee, but must be completed by the exhibitor. Style of arrangement and rose varieties \{ARS Am. Exhibition Name\} must be written on each entry card.
10. Arrangements must be picked up (claimed) on Sunday, October 15, 2023, between 5:00 PM and 6:00 PM. All containers should be marked with exhibitor's name. No arrangements may be removed from the show area prior to pick up time.

## A. The Lee Jeremias Memorial Award - A Standard Modern Design - Eligible for SC Rose Society Lee

 Jeremias Memorial Award. Designer's choice of modern style to be written at the top of the entry tag. Open only to members of the SC Rose Society.Class 1 - "The Rocket"
B. Royalty Award - A Standard Traditional Design - Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates. Designer's choice of style to be written at the top of the entry tag. Fresh roses with fresh and/or dried plant material; fresh fruit and/or vegetables allowed.

Class 2 - "Carousel" - Mass or Line-Mass Design
Class 3 - "Corn Dog" - Line or Line-Mass Design
C. Artist Award - A Standard Modern Design - Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates. Designer's choice of style to be written at the top of the entry tag. Fresh roses with designer's choice of any other plant materials and components except as previously noted.

Class 4 - "Roller Coaster"
Class 5 - "The Bullet"

## D. East Asian Award - Standard East Asian Design - Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates.

 Designer's choice of style to be written at the top of the entry tag. Fresh roses with designer's choice of any other plant materials and components except as previously noted or prohibited by the design type.Class 6 - "Tilt-A-Whir"" - any East Asian Style besides East Asian Free Style (Jiyuka)
Class 7. "Hall of Mirrors" - East Asian Free Style (Jiyuka)
E. Mini Royalty Award - Miniature Traditional Design - Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates. Designer's choice of style to be written at the top of the entry tag.

Class 8. "Balloons" - Mass or Line-Mass Design
Class 9. "Cotton Candy" - Line or Line-Mass Design
F. Mini Artist Award - Miniature Modern Design - Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates. Designer's choice of style to be written at the top of the entry tag.

Class 10. "Bump Cars"
Class 11. "Rubber Ducky"
G. Mini East Asian Award - Miniature East Asian Design - Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates. Designer's choice of style to be written at the top of the entry tag.

Class 12. "Funnel Cake" - any East Asian Style besides East Asian Free Style (Jiyuka)
Class 13. "Fireworks" - East Asian Free Style (Jiyuka)
H. Duke Award. Eligible for ARS Design Awards and Certificates. Designer's choice of style to be written at the top of the entry tag. Arrangements must be larger than 10 inches in height, width, and depth, but no greater than 20 inches in any direction.

Class 14. "The Grand Champion"
