EMIKO SUZUKI

Emiko Suzuki is a Senior Professor, 2nd Grade, of the Ikenobo School of Ikebana headquartered in Kyoto, Japan. She began studying Ikenobo Ikebana in Japan in 1986 and taught Ikebana to students of all ages for 13 years in Japan before moving to the United States.



Emiko graduated from Western North Carolina University with a Masters of Arts in Teaching in May 2011 and with a Masters of Fine Art in December 2014. Recently she completed the Tokubetsuka, the Advanced Course of the Ikenobo Central Training Institute, IKENOBO Headquarters, Kyoto, where she received the highest Free Style Ikebana score at the final exam. She completed the sogo-Tokubetsu-ka with the Rikka course.

Emiko always tries to bring the Japanese cultural spirit to local organizations through her teaching of Ikebana, tea ceremony and other aspects of Japanese culture. She has presented demonstrations and workshops at Ikebana regional meetings in North Carolina, Texas, California and Colorado. Currently she serves as president of Blue Ridge Chapter of Ikenobo Ikebana Society and is a member of the Asheville Chapter of Ikebana International.
